ORGANIC WASTE 💣

> BROWN CONTAINER - ORGANIC WASTE BAG

All organic waste suitable for composting, such as plant and garden waste, fruit and vegetable waste; coffee and tea filters; coffee grounds; spoilt food without containers; raw or cooked food waste (pasta, rice, meat, fish, cheese peelings, small bones); ashes from the fireplace; matches; non-synthetic pet litter (e.g. made from sand, shavings, sawdust or clay); toothpicks; corks; dirty napkins and cloths; biodegradable bags (with specific logo). non-synthetic pet litter (e.g. made from sand, shavings, sawdust or clay); toothpicks; corks; dirty napkins and cloths; biodegradable bags (with specific logo). Please note: no mussel or shellfish shells.



GLASS 🍄

> GREEN CONTAINER

All glass bottles and glass containers, e.g. jam and honey jars, fruit and vegetable jars; bottles for oil, vinegar and sauces; juice bottles, wine and champagne bottles. Attention: no crystal glasses, lamps, crockery and baking tins, porcelain, mirrors, coffee cups, window glass.



PAPER, CARTOBOARD, TETRAPAK

Newspapers; magazines; writing paper; books; calendars; cardboard packaging; paper bags; pizza boxes without leftovers; tetra-pack containers for drinks, milk, juices, wine, etc. (they must be empty, rinsed and flattened). (they must be empty, rinsed and flattened). Attention: No paper with glue residues or other substances, baking paper, receipts, dirty napkins and cloths.



MULTIMATERIAL (PLASTIC AND CANS)

Aluminium, tin and plastic lids, food cans and cups, e.g. tuna, tomatoes, peas; aluminium cans; pharmaceutical blister packs; yoghurt cups; shopping bags and fruit and vegetable bags made of plastic; plastic shipping packaging; crown caps; plastic drinks bottles; plastic trays and films for food (e.g. for meat, fish, vegetables); trays for ready meals; noodle bags; empty cleaning and detergent bottles; refill bags, e.g. for detergents, liquid soap or fruit and vegetable soap. (e.g. for meat, fish, vegetables); trays for ready meals; noodle bags; empty cleaning and detergent bottles; refill bags, e.g. for detergent, liquid soap or fruit puree; shampoo bottles; empty aerosol cans; soup and brine sachets, pet food cans and bowls; toothpaste tubes, etc.



RUR (NON RECYCABLE WASTE)

> GREY CONTAINER WITH TRANSPARENT BAG

Synthetic animal bedding; cigarette butts; CDs and cassettes; pens and pencils; sanitary towels; tampons; nappies; cotton buds; plasters and syringes (sometimes used at home), small toys and knick-knacks; rubber; cosmetics; broken umbrellas; small worn clothing (e.g. socks); toothbrushes and razors; sponges; hoover bags; dust; lint; crumbs; receipts and baking paper.
